We are pleased to announce that Roadcheck 2009, the 22<sup>nd</sup> annual international truck and bus safety event, will be held June 2-4 throughout the United States, Canada and Mexico. As in the previous 21 Roadcheck events, this year's activities will focus on commercial vehicle and driver safety and security programs aimed at making North American highways safer and more secure for everyone. One of this year's focus areas is to get industry more active, therefore we are requesting your participation in Roadcheck 2009.

In 2008, the seventy-two hour truck and bus inspection effort included 67,931 inspections performed over the 3 day event held June 3-5. 9,148 inspectors participated in the event at 1,683 locations throughout North America. We want to continue to raise awareness of CMV safety, and we need your help. Safety is everyone's responsibility, and we would like industry to help in spreading the word.
